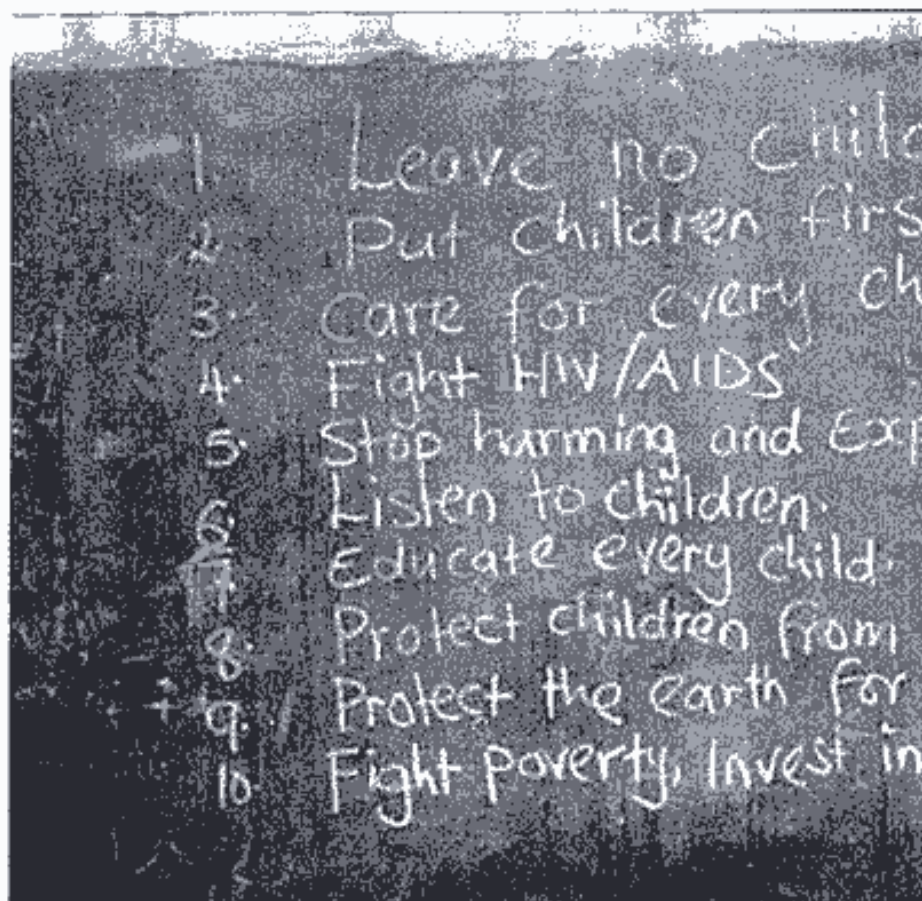
Maluba & "La Gabbianella"

- ❖ to support the politic, social and economic development of each country in the respect of there different culture.

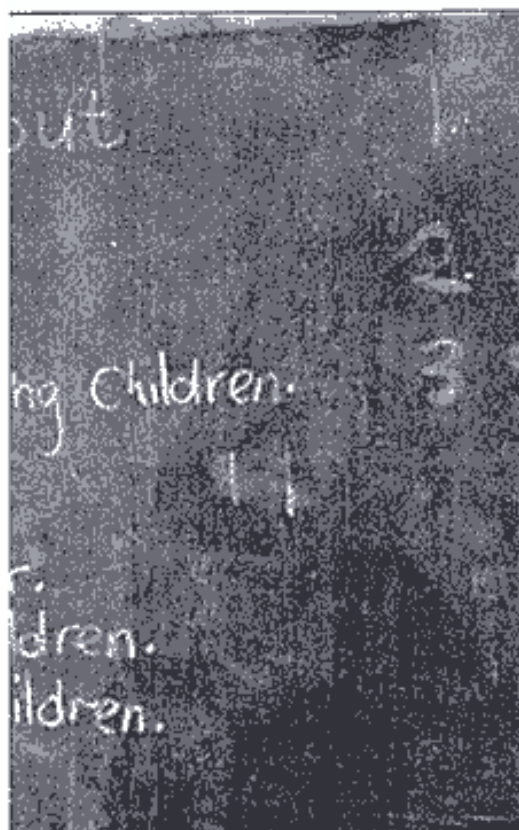
